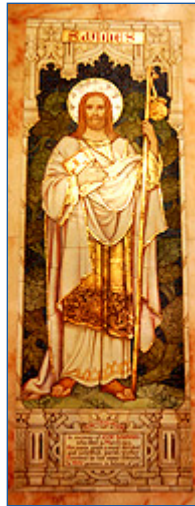


# Mosaics

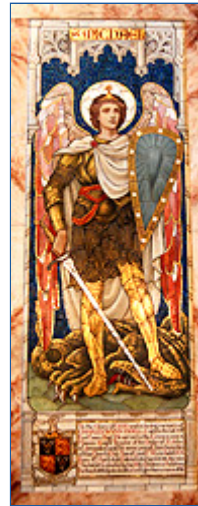
There are four beautifully worked mosaics, each surrounded by a marble border, at the east end of both the north and south aisles.



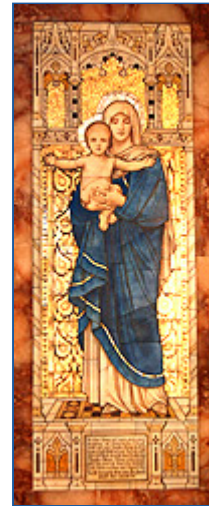
Christ the King

4th April 1838.  
Entered into his  
rest 28th July  
1905. This  
tablet is  
erected by his  
wife, children  
and relatives.

Born 3rd July  
1848 at rest

Also their  
dearly beloved  
only son  
Charles Henry  
Wynn entered  
into his rest at  
Nairobi British  
East Africa  
11th May 1917,  
aged 43.  
"So He bringeth  
them into the  
Haven where  
they would be"*
