Choir stalls

Choir stalls are the fixed seats in the chancel where the choir sit. There are two rows each side of the chancel which face each other. The sopranos and basses in the choir usually sit on the side with the organ and the altos and tenors in the choir usually sit opposite them. The stalls are made of wood and the ends are beautifully carved, as shown in the pictures below.
